LOSTINLAYOUT GALLERY presents **BEYOND THE GAZE**, an exhibition set within the spaces of Parco dell'Arte Ceribelli.

A visual dialogue between two radical and complementary artistic visions: those of **MICHAEL IRABOR** and **TIBERIO D'AQUINO**.


The title **BEYOND THE GAZE** refers to what lies beyond the surface of the face: an inquiry into the self as a mutable entity, shaped by memories, symbols, and cultural forces. The exhibition offers an immersive experience that merges African spirituality with contemporary graphic language, psychic expression with visual experimentation. These works do not merely represent – they act as thresholds, liminal zones where identity is continuously deconstructed and reconstructed.

Through different but synergistic approaches, Irabor and D'Aquino explore the face as a mask: no longer an individual portrait, but a symbolic space of transformation. An exhibition that invites viewers to look beyond, to cross the visible in search of new forms of feeling and representation.

ARTISTS ON SHOW

MICHAEL IRABOR (1997, Lagos, Nigeria) is a multidisciplinary artist working across visual arts, illustration, and textiles. With a background that includes the University of Lagos, the Istituto Europeo di Design in Rome, and the Accademia Costume & Moda, Irabor blends culture, personal storytelling, and bold graphic abstraction to create a distinctive style that transcends disciplinary boundaries.

TIBERIO D'AQUINO (1972, Rome, Italy) is a visual artist who works outside the conventional dynamics of the art market, pursuing an independent and uninterrupted creative path since his early training. His research spans illustration, graphic design, and design, with a strongly experimental approach deeply influenced by the Roman electronic music scene of the 1990s and early 2000s, particularly through the Chaos/Order collective.


MICHAEL IRABOR:

FROM THE SERIES MUTE MOJOS. Mute Mojoes is a body of work that introduces a universe inhabited by playful and ambiguous characters inspired by totems and masks. In this series, Nigerian artist Michael Irabor fuses African cultural references with a contemporary graphic expressiveness. Drawing on carved Tikis, abstracted human forms, and ritual masks, Irabor reinterprets traditional symbols into stylized portraits rooted in everyday Nigerian life.

Each figure functions as a mask – a tool for transformation and a gateway to a spiritual dimension, in continuity with African practices where masks convey the presence of a spirit and allow the subject to embody it. The Mojoes series reimagines the concept of portraiture by juxtaposing figures inspired by Tikis with conventional family portraits, reflecting on African aesthetic standards through exaggerated forms, hairstyles, and accessories.





Attraverso approcci diversi ma sinergici, Irabor e D'Aquino esplorano il volto come maschera: non più ritratto individuale, ma spazio simbolico di trasformazione. Una mostra che invita a guardare oltre, ad attraversare il visibile per scoprire nuove forme del sentire e del rappresentare.

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ARTISTI IN MOSTRA

MICHAEL IRABOR (1997, Lagos, Nigeria) è un artista multidisciplinare attivo nel campo delle arti visive, dell'illustrazione e del tessile. Con una formazione che include l'Università di Lagos, l'Istituto Europeo di Design di Roma e l'Accademia Costume & Moda, Irabor fonde cultura, narrazione personale e astrazione grafica audace per creare uno stile distintivo che trascende i confini disciplinari.

TIBERIO D'AQUINO (1972, Roma, Italia) è un artista visivo che opera al di fuori delle dinamiche del mercato dell'arte, portando avanti un percorso creativo indipendente e ininterrotto sin dalla sua formazione. La sua ricerca spazia tra illustrazione, graphic design e design, con un approccio fortemente sperimentale, influenzato in modo decisivo dalla scena musicale elettronica romana degli anni '90 e primi 2000, in particolare con il collettivo Chaos/Order.

MICHAEL IRABOR:


DALLA SERIE MUTE MOJOS. Mute Mojós è una serie di opere che introduce un universo abitato da personaggi giocosi e ambigui, ispirati a totem e maschere, in cui l'artista nigeriano Michael Irabor fonde riferimenti culturali africani con un'espressività grafica contemporanea. Attingendo a Tikis scolpiti, forme umane astratte e maschere rituali, Irabor reinterpreta simboli tradizionali in ritratti stilizzati radicati nella vita quotidiana nigeriana. Ogni figura funziona come una maschera: strumento di trasformazione e connessione con una dimensione spirituale, in continuità con le pratiche africane in cui le maschere veicolano la presenza di uno spirito e permettono al soggetto di incarnarlo. La serie Mojós reinterpreta il concetto di ritratto contrapponendo figure ispirate ai Tikis a ritratti familiari convenzionali, riflettendo sugli standard estetici africani attraverso forme esagerate, accosciature e accessori.
